### Immaculate Conception Explained

In our Catholic tradition, December 8th, is the day we mark the "Feast of the Immaculate Conception". In this instance, a feast does not mean a big meal, but a special day to mark a significant person or event. The Immaculate Conception refers to the Catholic belief that Mary, the mother of Jesus, was born without sin, she was immaculate. In this way, she was ready to carry Jesus, the son of God. Our school is named after this amazing miracle.

This year we will celebrate the Feast of the Immaculate Conception in the hall with our fellow students on Friday, December 6th.

Students will gather in the hall to eat lunch together and receive a cupcake. We ask that parents bring a treat for their child if they have dietary restrictions that will not allow them to receive a cupcake.


