

Looking Forward

Language Arts: This month, students will be starting The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe for a class novel study. We will also keep working on our writing and spelling skills.

- Apply a variety of thinking skills to gain meaning from texts.
- Use a variety of comprehension strategies before, during, and after reading, listening, or viewing to guide inquiry and deepen understanding of the text.

Math: Continuing in Jump Math students will work more with division, and multiplication and we will get into measurements and conversions.

• Develop and use multiple strategies to engage in problem-solving.

Social Studies: Students will explore key topics related to immigration, identity, and the Canadian Government. They will learn about the diverse history of immigration to Canada, how different communities shape our national identity, and the structure of the Canadian government.

• Construct arguments defending the significance of individuals/groups, places, events, and developments.

Science: We are going to start Body Systems this month. All the systems work together to support the body's overall function and health.

• Questioning and predicting.

Careers: We will be goal-setting for the term, looking at and researching careers.

• Set realistic short- and longer-term learning goals, define a path, and monitor progress.

Art: Students will be exploring perspective and starting an artist study on Emily Carr learning about her art and techniques

• Observe, listen, describe, inquire and predict how artists (visual artists) use processes, materials, movements, technologies, tools, techniques, and environments to create and communicate.
